

**Australian Contaminated Land Consultants Association (ACLCA) Young Professionals
Sub-Committee Photography Competition
Rules and Terms**

- 1)** The subject for the Australian Contaminated Land Consultants Association (ACLCA) Young Professional Sub-Committee Photography Competition 2011 is "Contaminated Land and Natural Environments". The theme is open to individual interpretation, but photos should capture a scene or site, which makes the rest of us wish we'd been there to see it. Photographs can feature activities, environments or the successful completion of remediation projects. Photographs of domestic animals, i.e. pets, and cultivated plants are not eligible.
 - 2)** Entrants can submit **up to two photos** in JPEG format of file size less than 5 MB. Only one photo by any individual entrant can be included in the final shortlist.
 - 3)** Images may be digitally enhanced to remove spots or scratches, but not manipulated. Entrants can enhance the picture to make it brighter, clearer etc., but not manipulate the content.
 - 4)** The competition is open to **ACLCA Member Company Employees only**.
 - 5)** Members of the Young Professionals Judging panel, may enter the competition but are not eligible for the for competition prizes.
 - 6)** Each entry should include the following information: Entrant name, member company, contact email and a brief description of where the photo was taken and what it depicts (<50 words).
 - 7)** Entries should be submitted to the Competition email: ACLCAYP@gmail.com.

 - 9)** The competition closes at **5 pm on Friday 2 December 2011**. Entries received after this date will not be considered.
 - 10)** All photographs will be judged by the Young Professionals Sub-Committee on the following criteria:
 - Subject matter relevant to the Contaminated Land Industry (40%);
 - Composition and Technical ability (30%);
 - Originality (30%).
- Based on these criteria the following prizes will be awarded:
- First Place - voucher worth \$90 from JB Hi-Fi.
 - Second Place - voucher worth \$40 from JB Hi-Fi
 - Third Place - voucher worth \$20 from JB Hi-Fi
- 11)** All entries must be the original work of the entrant and must not infringe the rights of any other party. The entrants must be the sole owner of copyright in all photographs entered and must have obtained permission of any people featured in the entries. Further, entrants must not have breached any laws when taking their photographs.
 - 12)** Entrants will retain copyright in the photographs that they submit in this competition. By entering the competition all entrants grant to ACLCA the right to publish and exhibit their photographs in print, on the ACLCA website and during ACLCA courses, seminars, meetings and activities.
